Hesperian Harry's Vineyard 2005, an authentic legacy wine, shows its delicate balance of bramble fruit that transitions to a long truffle and earthy finish would complement all meat dishes from veal to porterhouse.

Vineyard

I discovered Harry's Vineyard in 2003 when I was sourcing some Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc for Sullivan Vineyards, where I worked at the time. I immediately fell in love with it. I could see the vineyard had great potential with its steep slopes, volcanic and rocky soil, and densely planted. It was picturesque and the owners, Harry and Gail, are wonderful people.

The Harvest

2005 was a cooler vintage, even so bud break was earlier than average but since the weather remained relatively cool vines grew slower than normal. This was a vintage where you had to your nerves, especially before harvest. This created a tight and highly structured wine in it youth, one with good acidity.
