



2007 Hesperian Cabernet Sauvignon

Description

2007 produced very classical wines. This wine was created by blending the wines coming from three vineyards. A hint of orange appears on the rim. It is delicious now (03/16/20) with floral notes mingling with blueberry, blackberry, mint and a hint of leather. The wine is medium bodied, very balanced, silky and plush. It marries gracefully power and finesse. An extremely long finish with floral notes, laurel, violet and dried fruit.

25 % Tony's Vineyard on Spring Mountain
19 % Tom's Vineyard in Rutherford

The Harvest

2007 had ideal growing conditions; never too cold and never too hot. Plant and berry development was textbook. The only heat spike occurred in late August but September was on the cooler side which allowed for slow, steady development of flavors while maintaining the acidity of the grapes.
